Community and Allied Health Services Fees - Community Health Clients



CGH Community and Allied Health Services Fees: These service fees cover cost per unit of CGH services. Any associated costs such as consumables, resources, and equipment hire, are not included and will be charged in addition to the service fee.

Community Health Program Eligibility:

The following people, including children and young people, are eligible to receive services through the Community Health Program:

- People who hold a healthcare or pensioner concession card, or who are a dependent of a concession card holder
- People with a low or medium income
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people
- Refugees and people seeking asylum
- People who are homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Children in care, child protection, Orange Door and ChildFIRST clients
- For the purposes of this service, a child/young person is defined as a person aged under 18 years.

Cancellation of services: Notice of cancellation for services must be provided as early as possible. If notification to cancel service/s is not received, the fees applicable to the service may be charged.

Minimum time: All services are for minimum of 30 minutes with 30-minute increments thereafter.

Income Ranges: Community Health Income ranges are determined by the Department of Health.
